- ▶ It is a **PARTNERSHIP** with ASA–NM members & New Mexico OSHA
- ▶ **Philosophy:** To educate our participants in creating the safest work environment possible and to create a “safety culture” based on a behavioral model of safety rather than just an enforcement model.
- ▶ **Goals & Objectives:**
  - Reduce injuries
  - Encourage implementation of effective safety programs covering all aspects of workplace safety.
  - Implement road–based safety training and education – sharing safety knowledge and best practices.
  - Make our participants able to create safe and productive worksites and projects.
  - Create an industry wide “higher standard” of safety awareness.
  - Set goals and standards of best practices.
  - Create a program that assesses and tracks safety and injury trends and “action plans” to address those trends.
  - Lower EMODS and insurance costs.
  - Lower liability and risks.
- ▶ **Why Should You Participate?**
  - The construction industry is consistently one of the most dangerous occupations.
  - Specialty trade subcontractors employ the majority of the workers on any given job site which means their employees have the most exposure for potential injury on job sites.
  - Reduces injuries and decreases indemnity claim costs which results in a lower EMOD.
  - Helps you to meet pre–qualification requirements.
