How to Join Construction Industry Crime Alliance Crime Fighting Partnership:

Go to www.connectabq.org

- On the left side under "CONNECT" click on the "Join Now" Link
- Then you will be directed to a new page and you can click on "Become an CICA Partner"
- You will then fill out the form Check the "I Agree" box and hit submit. Once you have submitted the form, it will allow you to print a copy and send to your ASA-NM point of contact.
